For each member Wimborne Civic Society holds some or all of the following information:

Name, Postal Address, Email Address, Telephone Number, Newsletter Delivery Method, and whether the subscription for the year has been paid.

The information is kept in an encrypted computer file.

The information is used:

To enable the Society to carry out its aims as specified in its constitution;

To inform members of news, events, and activities, and to distribute the Newsletter;

To facilitate and record the collection of subscriptions and administer membership records.

The information is kept purely for the use of the Society for the above purposes. It is not given or shared with any other body.

The information is collected from Application Forms or Annual Renewal Forms on which the member agrees to this use of the information.

A member may refuse to allow the Society to hold the information or ask for it to be removed. The consequence would be that the member would not automatically receive a Newsletter and might only be admitted to meetings as a Non-member.

Members may ask to see the data held about themselves. The information will not unreasonably be withheld.
